The following list shows what I used, but don't feel the need to run out and buy things you don't have. Almost any paper or canvas you normally use for acrylic painting will work; almost any brushes you already have should work. Craft paint should work, although coverage varies by color and brand.

- 6" x 8" 300 lb Fabriano Artistico Hot Press Watercolor Paper
- Golden Glazing Liquid (slows drying time & helps flow)
- Simply Simmons brushes (mostly filberts and angles)
- The Art Sherpa detail brushes
- Tracing Paper
- Transfer Paper
- Graphite Pencil (for tracing traceable onto tracing paper)
- Ball Point Pen (for transferring image from tracing paper onto watercolor paper)
- Matte Medium (to seal the tracing on the watercolor paper)
- Hairdryer (optional)

- Golden Open Acrylics
 - Titanium White
 - Cad Yellow Primrose
 - Cad Red Light
 - Alizarin Crimson Hue
 - Sap Green Hue
 - Burnt Umber
 - Bone Black
